If the following situations also apply to your reapplication, contact your department for a new major/minor evaluation a month prior to the deadline. New evaluations can be approved by the department in one of three ways: (1) Note in Degree Works, (2) signed Degree Works PDF or (3) signed scanned evaluation.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • You have not been enrolled in the last 12 months • You are switching/adding a major • You are changing catalog year of your major <p>3. WWU Graduation Requirements:

- Minimum 180 credits
- Minimum 60 upper-division (300-400 level) credits
- Minimum 45 credits completed in residence (enrolled at WWU)
- Minimum of three writing proficiency (WP) points with a grade of C- or better
- Attend final quarter in residence (enrolled through WWU)
- Satisfied the GURs or Have a DTA
- Western GPA of at least 2.00
